## STADIUM ATTENDANCE

- Arrive at the stadium no longer than 15 minutes before your start time.
- Enter only via the main stadium entrance on Bent Street NO Entry via the carpark doors

There will be no spectators in any domestic or representative competition. One adult per child will be allowed entry into the stadium for all junior training, competition and programs Anyone not participating in the game must sign in when entering the stadium using either the QR Code or Sign in Book

We have a designated entry and exit into the stadium. Please follow the signage correctly. There are hand sanitiser facilities available when entering the exiting the stadium. Please use these facilities. Disinfectant wipes are available upon entry to wipe balls or training equipment.

- Disinfectant wipes are available upon entry to wipe balls or training equipment.
- Changerooms and Showers are closed except for a limited number of designated events
- Bathroom facilities are still available

# MATCH DAY PROCEDURES

- Maitland Basketball will be providing the ball for all competition games.

  - $\circ$   $\;$  This ball will not be available for team warm ups  $\;$
  - Players will be encouraged to bring their own ball for any training or warm ups.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Maitland Basketball will not be providing balls for loan or hire.
- There will be hand sanitiser available on each score bench and we encourage everyone to use this at timeouts and substitutions
- Players and Teams should not shake hands before or after games.
- Score benches will be regularly wiped down throughout the night.

By entering Maitland Federation Centre, you are agreeing to all of the above. Our staff and volunteers will assist in the enforcement of these measures, which are in place to ensure the safety of all people who attend our facility.
